One of the attributes that best characterizes the life of Abraham is faith. Abraham is listed in what we refer to as the "Hall of Faith" in Hebrews 11:8. We know that Abraham had the faith to believe God when God promised him a son even though he and his wife were well past childbearing age. And, after God gave them a son Abraham trusted God and acted in faith taking that son, Isaac, to the top of Mt. Moriah to sacrifice him. We

know that God intervened and stopped the sacrifice but the Bible tells us that Abraham's faith was counted to him for righteousness. But before Isaac was born and before Abraham took him to the top of Mount Moriah in obedience to God it all started with God calling Abraham to follow Him by faith. The call was simple from God to Abraham. God called Abraham to "follow Him". Much like when Jesus called the disciples to come and follow Him and when the Holy Spirit called us to follow Him in salvation. Whether it is Abraham, the disciples or us the call to follow Him is a call into faith.

In order to journey with God we must have faith.

Faith is what it takes to please God – Hebrews 11:6

God will test our faith – James 1:2-4

We walk by faith – 2 Corinthians 5:7 "We walk by faith, not by sight".

When God called Abraham, Abraham obeyed and followed (vs. 4). The only response that faith knows is obedience.

This walk of faith is not easy. Abraham learned some things in his journey of faith that I want to share with you that will help you journey with God.

GOD DOESN'T MAKE ANY MISTAKES (vs. 1).

Maybe you are afraid of where God may lead. Maybe you feel as if God doesn't know what He is doing. But I want to remind you to keep walking with God by faith because He doesn't make any mistakes!

GOD KNOWS HOW TO TAKE CARE OF THOSE WHO FOLLOW HIM (vs. 4-6, 8).

There is an old saying with which I am sure you are familiar, "Where God guides, He provides". When we are on journey with God, following Him by faith, we have that assurance.

GOD WILL ALWAYS KEEP HIS PROMISES (vs. 2-3, 7a).

These looked like impossible promises in light of their present circumstances. There were times when Abraham lost faith. There were times when he tried to help God fulfill the promises but God restored Abraham and he continued to journey by faith.

Will you journey with Him?
